- Since 2008, STRONG STAR has assessed and treated over 8,000 service members with various psychological health conditions at Fort Cavazos.
- This includes over 25,000 hours of clinical services provided, saving DHA millions of dollars in clinical care costs.

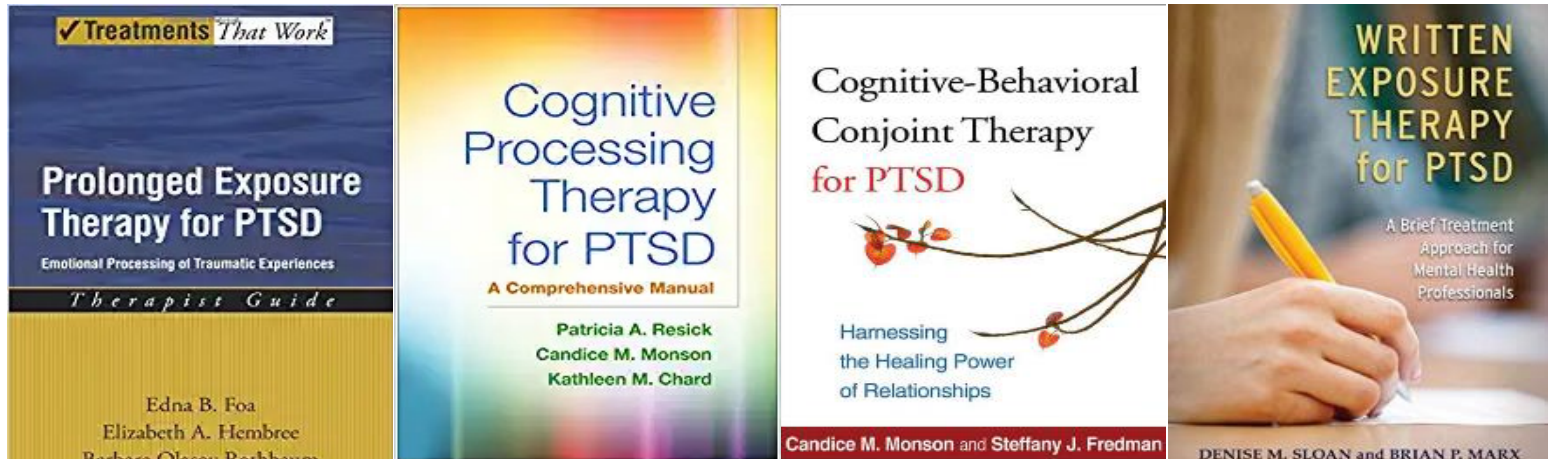

STRONG STAR PTSD RCTs

- STRONG STAR conducted the first randomized clinical trials (RCTs) to evaluate trauma-focused cognitive-behavioral therapies previously demonstrated to be effective in civilian and veteran populations → **Apply to AD population.**
 - Prolonged Exposure Therapy
 - Cognitive Processing Therapy
 - Cognitive Behavioral Couples Therapy
 - Written Exposure Therapy

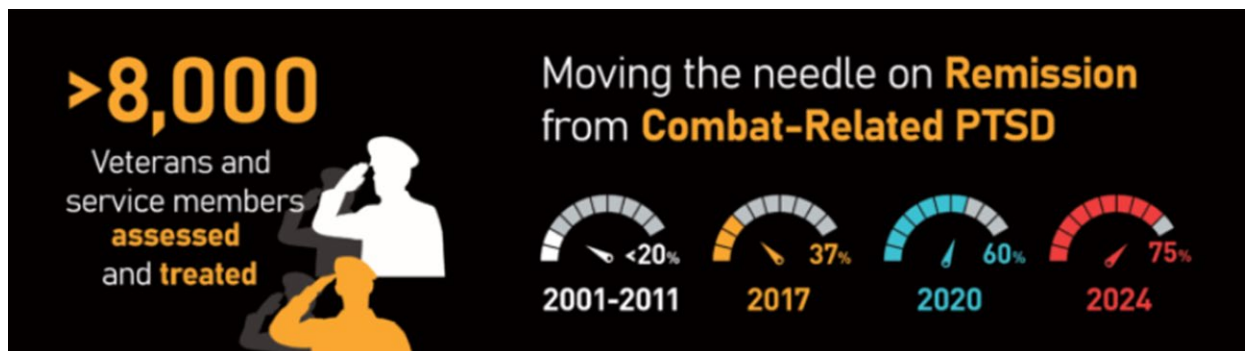
Initial Findings and Subsequent Work

- Treatment protocols developed for civilian and veteran populations were found to be effective in active-duty service members, **with room for improvement.**
- Treatments have subsequently been tailored and adapted to meet the needs of active-duty military personnel.
 - Massed treatments (**shorter duration**)
 - Combining treatment with medications and devices
- At the same time, other STRONG STAR trials are evaluating the treatment of comorbid conditions such as sleep disturbance, pain, post-concussive symptoms, anger, suicidal thoughts and behaviors.

Benefits of STRONG STAR Research

- Expertise in conducting research with active-duty military personnel.
- Brings DoD funding to provide research staff to support projects.
 - Project coordinators, independent evaluators, behavioral health providers
- Provides expert clinical assessment and diagnosis.
- Clinical trials designed so that **all participants benefit** from participation.
- **Rapid access** to assessment and a full dose of evidence-based treatments.
- Warm hand-off back to military providers for patients ineligible for studies.
- Brings **positive** media **attention** to DoD, DHA, and individual MTFs.

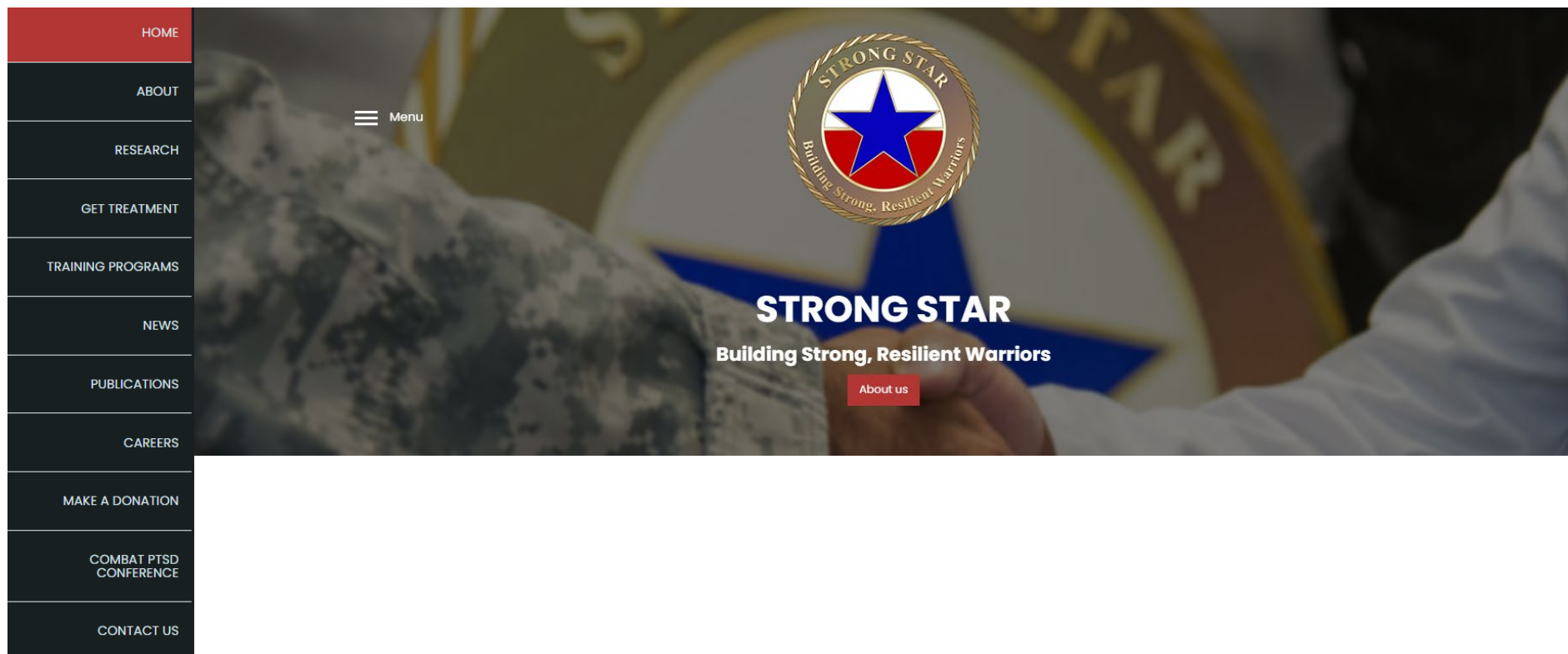
Command Confidence and Support is Critical

- Participation in STRONG STAR research is **voluntary**, IAW DoDI 3216.02.
- The evaluation of the effectiveness of treatments require that **Soldiers be available** for assessment and treatment appointments.
- Typically participating Soldiers will attend treatment appointments **during duty time**. The amount of time away from duty varies depending upon the type of study and type of treatment.
- STRONG STAR staff will work closely with Soldiers, supervisors, and commanders to limit the impact of treatment and study participation on duty requirements and training schedules.

- Internally Evaluated by Garrison Staff
- Scheduled 06 - 07 May 2025 (Tuesday – Wednesday) to exercise response procedures
 - **Day One (Respond)** – DES Response, emergency response procedures South of Carl R. Darnall (CRDAMC), EOC activates, Emergency Family Assistance Center (EFAC), establish and maintain COP, supports first responders and responds to MSEL injects.
PAUSEX ~1500
 - **Day Two (Recovery)** – Continue EOC operations. ENDEX ~1200 based on achieving training objectives.
- Incident event begins 0800 hrs. with activation of “Giant Voice” emergency test message
 - Announcements preceded and followed by phrases such as “EXERCISE, EXERCISE, EXERCISE”.
