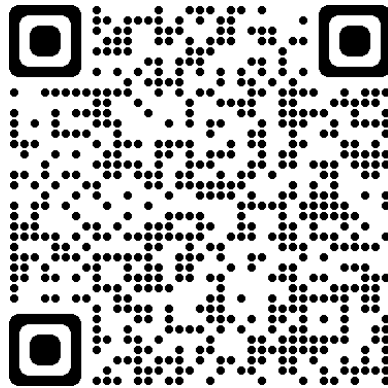

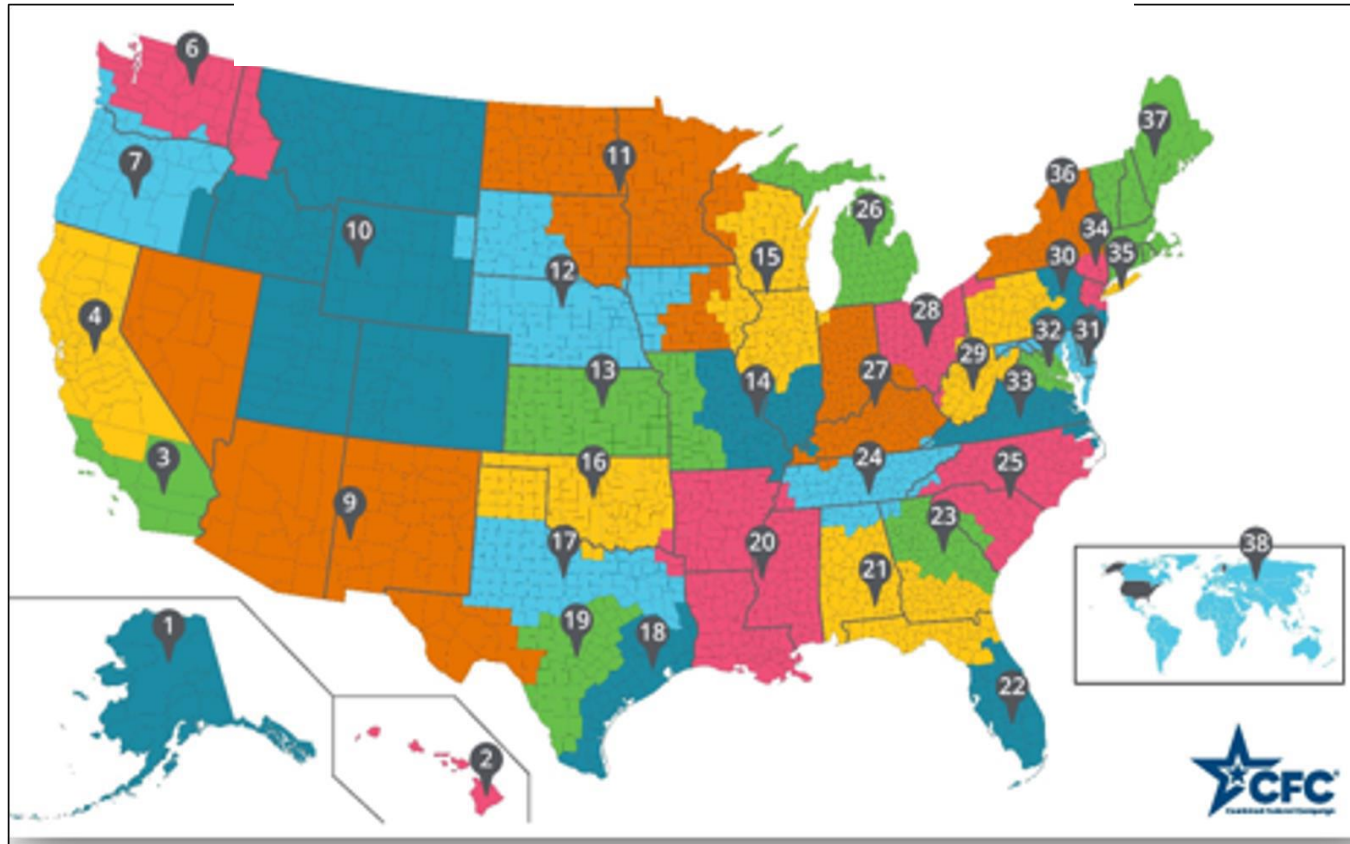

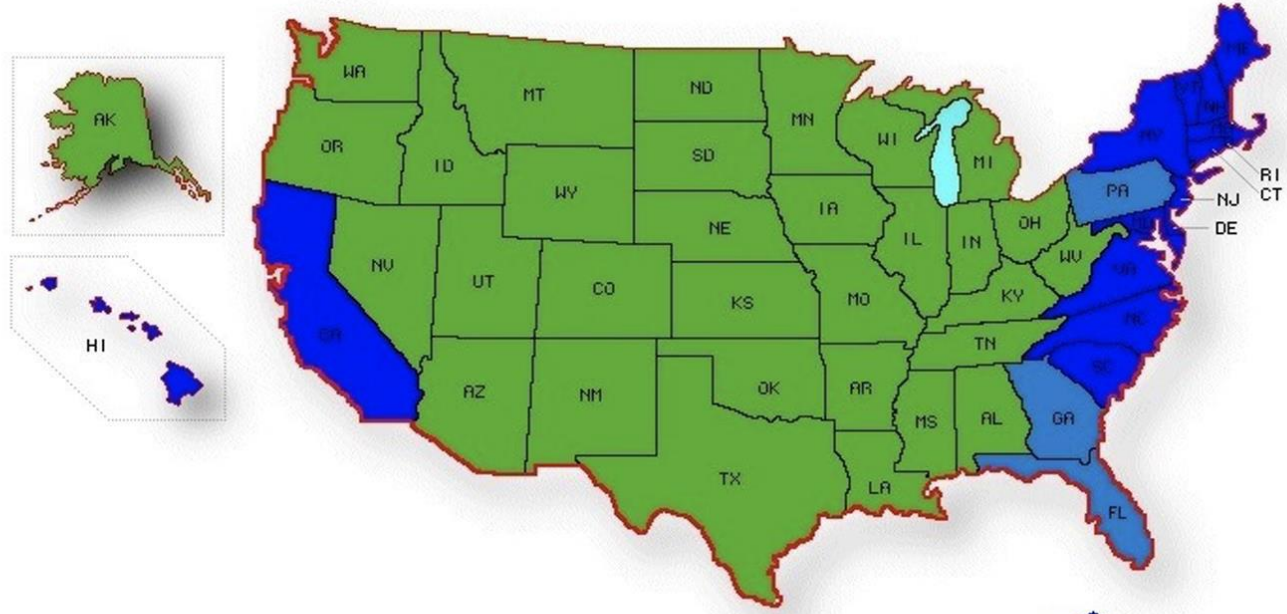


Local CFC Zones – Outreach Coordinator Map

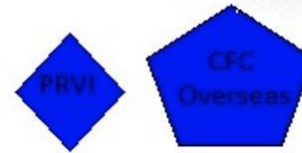

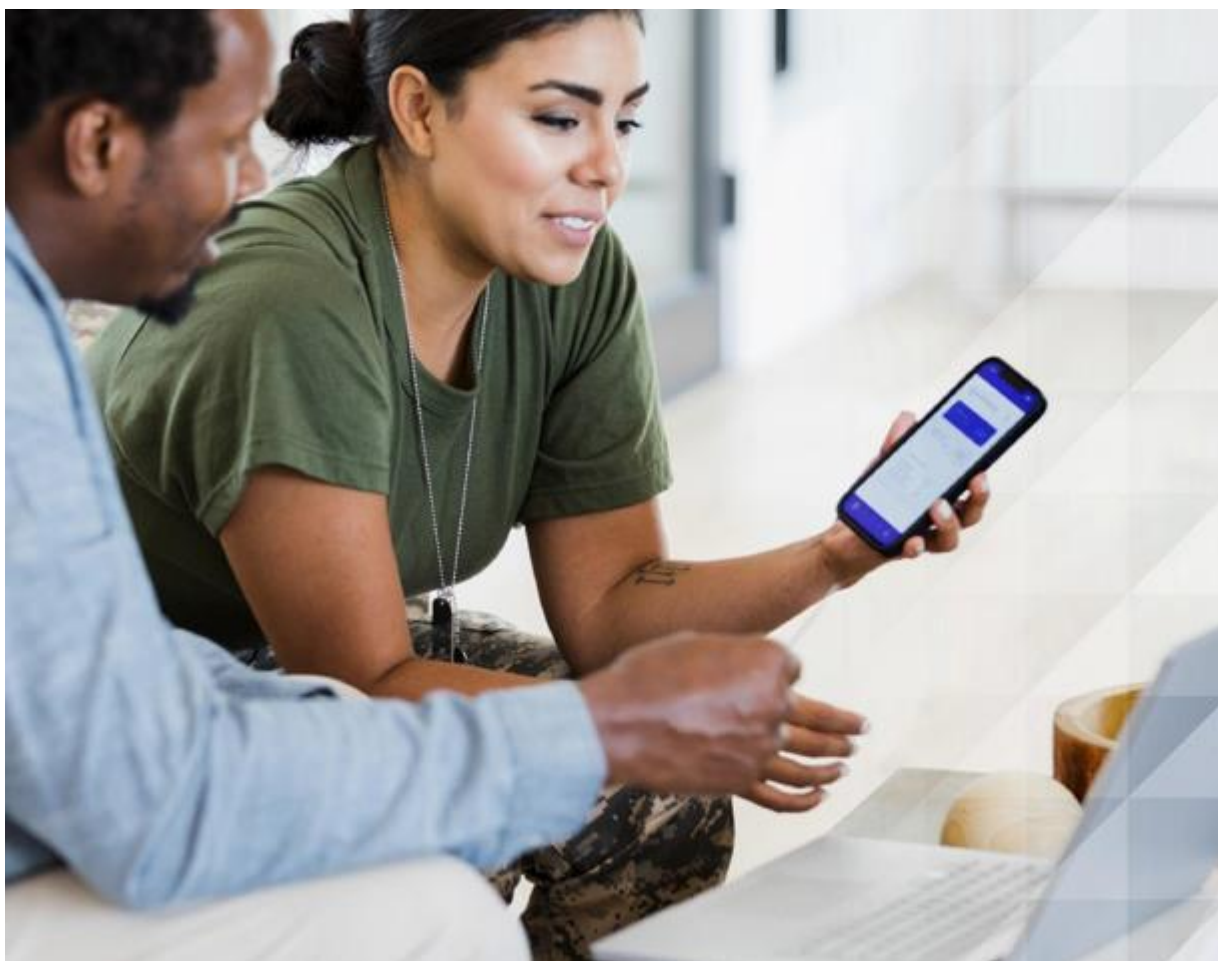

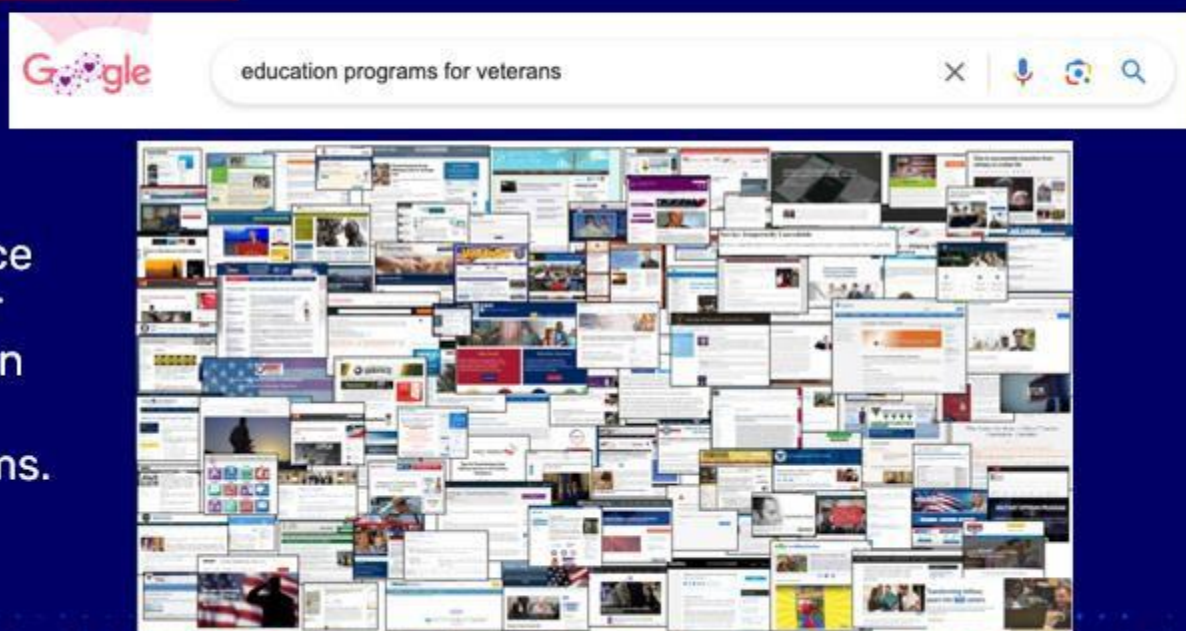

SUCCESS STORIES

A FEMALE VETERAN CONNECTED WITH TVN SEEKING HOUSING SUPPORT FOR HERSELF AND HER SON DUE TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. SHE WAS CONNECTED WITH SAFEHAVEN OF TARRANT COUNTY, ALLOWING HER TO SECURE A NEW HOME. FURTHERMORE, SHE RECEIVED ASSISTANCE FROM WOUNDED WARRIOR PROJECT FOR HER VA CLAIM, AND HER SON WAS LINKED TO A COUNSELING PROGRAM TAILORED FOR CHILDREN WHO HAVE EXPERIENCED DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. THESE RESOURCES CONTRIBUTED SIGNIFICANTLY TO THE VETERAN AND HER SON'S JOURNEY TOWARDS REBUILDING THEIR LIVES.

A ARMY VETERAN FACED FRUSTRATION AFTER BEING LAID OFF DURING A RELOCATION. HOWEVER, THROUGH TVN'S INTAKE TEAM, HE FOUND A PATH FORWARD. THANKS TO HIS CONNECTION TO TVC EMPLOYMENT, HE SECURED A JOB, AND HE AND HIS SPOUSE ACCESSED VITAL MENTAL HEALTH AND SUPPORT RESOURCES. THIS SUCCESS STORY SHOWCASES HOW TVN'S HOLISTIC APPROACH POSITIVELY IMPACTS VETERANS AND THEIR FAMILIES, FOSTERING RESILIENCE AND WELL-BEING DURING CHALLENGING TRANSITIONS.


