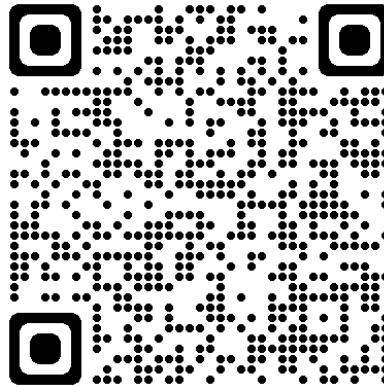

TOPIC 1: Belton Lake Levels/Recreation Opportunities

EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION: Water levels are so low the marina is beached, and the fishing dock area is closing in. Is dredging planned to make these areas functional again? Can beaches be extended so they are usable again?

PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION: Make alternations to BLORA to ensure it is still a functional and enjoyable recreation area during times of drought.

RESPONSE: Belton Lake water levels mainly depend on water levels of upstream revisors and watersheds from rain. Current levels are about 15 feet low, with a daily drop of about .03 feet per day. At this time, it is impossible to relocate the boat and fishing docks and still provide access to them; however, we are working to provide beach assess in the Sera beach area for recreational swimming.



TOPIC 2: Food Handler Certification for SFRG Volunteers

EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION: Preventative Medicine no longer offers in person classes for certification. The only alternative given by them was the only Safeservice course which has a \$1 fee for the course.

PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION: The alternative I found was Fort Hood VFW can conduct the class free of charge for their adopted units. My Question is there another resource that Ft. Hood offer at no cost to the unit or families?

RESPONSE: Family and MWR does not offer Food Handlers or Food Safety Managers training to units and family members. Family and MWR only cover the cost of the required Food Safety Managers certification for MWR managers with Food and Beverage operations. ServSafe or Learn to Sever are online options with fees ranging from \$7 to \$120


