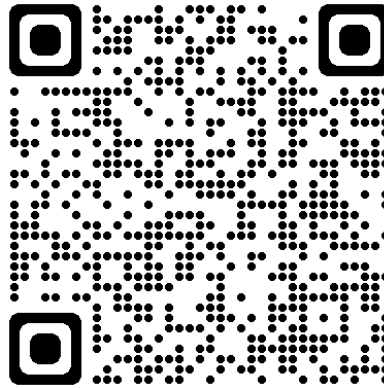



### Measles Concerns

### WHAT IS MEASLES (RUBEOLA)

Measles is a highly contagious, vaccine-preventable infectious disease caused by the measles virus. It is one of the most highly contagious and deadly infectious diseases in human history.

#### Symptoms

- COUGH**
- RUNNY NOSE**
- FEVER**
- WATERY, RED EYES**

**RASH** → **USUALLY STARTS 3 TO 5 DAYS AFTER THE OTHER SYMPTOMS.**

- Cough, runny nose, fever, or watery, red eyes begin 1 to 2 weeks after someone is exposed.
- 2 to 3 days after symptoms begin, tiny white spots (Koplik's spots) may appear inside the mouth.
- The rash usually starts 3 to 5 days after the other symptoms.

#### How It Spreads

You can get sick by breathing air with the measles virus in it.

- Measles can stay in the air and infect others for **up to 2 hours** after a contagious person has left a room.
- COUGHING, SNEEZING, OR TALKING
- SHARING ITEMS THAT HAVE SALIVA ON THEM, LIKE CUPS
- SOCIAL ACTIVITIES
- TOUCHING A SURFACE THAT HAS A VIRUS ON IT

Measles can spread 4 days before the rash starts through 4 days after it clears up.

WHAT ELSE SHOULD I KNOW?	IF YOU OR YOUR CHILD IS UNVACCINATED
-The measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccine is safe and effective at protecting against these viruses.	-The MMR vaccine may help prevent sickness if given within three days from when you were exposed.
-If you believe you are sick with measles, and need to seek care, CALL the medical facility BEFORE arriving.	-If exposed, you may need to quarantine for 21 days.
-Contact your health care provider to check your vaccine history.	-Talk to your healthcare provider to see what options are best for you or your child.

Measles can be prevented with 2 doses of Measles containing vaccine (MMR).

The Texas Department of State and Health Services reports 259 measles cases identified since late January, as of March 14. Thirty-four of the patients have been hospitalized and the Centers for Disease and Control has reported cases in many other States.

CRDAMC offers the vaccine in its pediatric and family medicine clinics. Patients receive two doses of MMR (measles, mumps, and rubella) vaccine at 12 months and four years of age, which is the guidance to prevent the virus from the Texas Department of State and Health Services and the Centers for Disease and Control. For exposure or vaccine related questions, patients should contact their assigned clinic or primary care manager.

## Healthcare Delivery Update



### TRICARE Online Patient Portal is Decommissioning

The Department of Defense (DoD) has fully transitioned to the new electronic health record system, **MHS GENESIS**, along with its **Patient Portal**. As a result, the **TOL Patient Portal** is set to be decommissioned.

#### What This Means for You:

- **Loss of Access to Legacy Electronic Health Records**
- **Healthcare Provider Access Remains**
- **Download Your Records Before April 1**
- **No Impact on VA Disability Claims**
- **Obtaining Copies of Health Records:** You can still obtain copies of your **legacy paper-based and electronic health records** at any military hospital or clinic.

#### Take Action Now

If you wish to keep personal copies of your **legacy electronic health records**, it is crucial to log in to the **TOL Patient Portal** and download them before **April 1**. Ensuring you have a record of your medical history can be beneficial for personal reference and future healthcare needs.

## CASA of Bell & Coryell Counties Overview

CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) of Bell and Coryell Counties is a **nonprofit organization** that provides **court-appointed volunteers** to advocate for children in foster care.

### Who is CASA?

- CASA of Bell and Coryell Counties is part of a national movement advocating for abused and neglected children in foster care.
- We recruit, train, and support volunteers who serve as Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASAs) for these children.
- CASA volunteers ensure that each child's best interests are represented in court, in schools, and in the community.

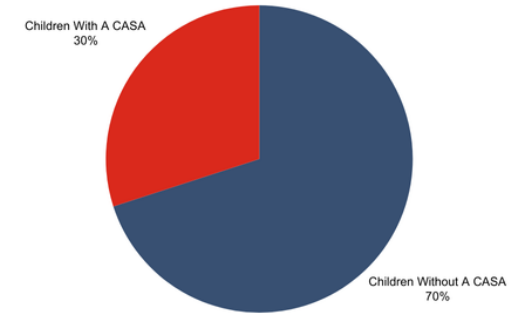

## CASA of Bell & Coryell Counties Impact

- Serves over 300 children annually
- Statistically, children who are assigned a CASA can find a safe and permanent home faster.
- Judges rely on CASA to give children a voice in court.



## Why is CASA important

- **Over 1,000 children** are currently in foster care in Bell and Coryell Counties.
- Bell County has seen a **20% increase in child abuse** and neglect cases since 2013 and is continuously ranked as one of the **top counties for child abuse** in the state of Texas.
- CASA is **only able to serve about 300** of them each year due to limited resources.
- Our biggest challenge is **recruiting and training more advocates** to meet this growing need.

- Fleet of Mobile Vet Centers used to provide services in Rural areas, emergency response, and in support of Veteran/Active-Duty Centric events.

## Vet Center Veteran and Active-Duty Counseling Eligibility

- Served on active military duty in any combat theater/war zone or area of hostility.
- Experienced Military Sexual Trauma (MST) and/or Harassment.
- Bereavement Counseling is available to families of service members who died while serving on active duty, to family members of Veterans or service members who die by suicide, and family members of a Veteran who was receiving Vet Center services at the time of the Veteran's death.

## Vet Center Veteran and Active-Duty Counseling Eligibility

- Response to National Emergency or Major Disaster Declared by the President.
- National Guard Under Orders of the Chief Executive of that State in Response to a Disaster or Civil Disorder in Such State.
- Anyone pursuing a course of education using VA covered educational assistance.
- Family Member of any deployed service member.

- Free and Confidential (Records are Separate from VHA and Military Records)
- No Referral or appointment needed to be seen – Walk-in




