Community Services Council Meeting 28 August 2024 Healthcare Delivery Update



The Fort Cavazos Department of Public Health confirmed two mosquito pools tested positive for the West Nile Virus (WNV). This is the first positive mosquito pool for this year that was trapped on Fort Cavazos.

The infected mosquito pool traps were collected near the Montague Village Housing Area located on West Fort Cavazos and the vicinity of T.J. Mills Blvd and Casa Blanca Rd. Mosquito numbers have decreased in recent weeks requiring no additional pest control treatment.

Symptoms of the West Nile Virus — which is most commonly spread through a bite from an infected mosquito and is not spread through coughing, sneezing, or touching other people or live animals — can include a fever, headache, body aches, skin rash and swollen lymph nodes.

Protect yourself and your loved ones by applying the "4D's" for prevention which aligns with CDC recommendations:

- 1. **DEET**: Whenever you're outside, use insect repellants that contain DEET or other EPA approved repellants and follow the instructions.
- **2. DRESS**: Wear long, loose and light-colored clothing outside.
- **3. DRAIN**: Remove all standing water in and around your home. Check places like gutters, birdbaths, tires, planters, etc.
- 4. DUSK & DAWN: Limit outdoor activities during dusk and dawn hours when mosquitoes are most active.



Community Services Council Meeting 28 August 2024 Play Therapy

- All Military Children have some level of relational trauma.
 - Multiple PCS moves
 - Parent/Caregiver deployments and rotations
 - Friends' PCS moves



 Play Therapy accesses a child's primary language PLAY to help them processes difficult emotions to reduce negative behaviors.







Trust Based Relational Intervention (TBRI) Child-Parent Relationship Therapy (CPRT)

- TBRI is an attachment-based, trauma-informed intervention designed to meet the complex needs of children with trauma backgrounds.
 - TBRI teaches parents and caregivers how to meet the needs of these children through empowering, connecting, and correcting principles
- CPRT the goal of CPRT is to strengthen the quality of the parentchild attachment bond as a means of reducing child behavior problems and stress in the parent-child relationship.
 - In CPRT, parents are taught specific skills that focus on enhancing a secure attachment with their child and helping parents attune to and respond to their child's underlying needs to address symptoms.

Community Services Council Meeting 28 August 2024 Back to School Safety

Tips for Drivers

- Be watchful around schools and bus stops for children running into the street.
- Watch for children entering the street from behind buses or running to catch the bus.
- Deliver and pick your children up as close to the school as possible. Don't leave until they are safely on school grounds.
- Drive slowly when approaching children riding bicycles and walking near the street.
- Watch your speed when entering school zones.



Traffic Signals/ Crossing Guards

- Never cross the street against a red light, even if you don't see any traffic coming. Wear reflective clothing and bright colors so drivers can see you easier.
- Plan a safe walking route to school or the bus stop. Choose the most direct way with the fewest street crossings and if possible, with intersections that have traffic controls.
- Advise children to arrive early for buses, stay out of the street, and to wait for the bus to come to a complete stop before approaching the street.



Children Supervision

- FC Regulation 420-37 (Housing Regulation) states-Children 10 years-old and under (or 11 years old if in the 5th grade) will have direct supervision (that is, line of sight) by a(n):
- Adult; Parent; Child, Youth & School Services (CYSS) site staff.
- Designated "responsible" teenager who is at least 13 years old.
- Children 12 years old (or 11 years old if in the 6th grade) will have monitored supervision.
- Parents may designate an <u>adult neighbor</u> with whom the child may "physically" check-in with at intervals.
- Parents must ensure that the child is capable and knowledgeable in handling emergency situations.
- Children 12 years old (or 11 years old if in the 6th grade) may be left unattended for no more than 6 hours, between the hours of 0600 to 2100, during a 24-hour period. Additionally, this age group may sign themselves in/out of a youth center for no more than 6 hours per day during youth center operating hours.
