Program Overview



The Army **Credentialing Assistance** (CA) Program provides funding for voluntary offduty courses and/or exams leading to an industry-recognized academic or vocational credential listed in ARMY COOL (<u>www.cool.osd.mil/army</u>)

What is a Credential?

An occupational license or certification used by an organization to assess and confirm the individual is competent and qualified to work in a designated field.

Soldier Benefits with Credentialing Assistance



- Enhance Military progression (promotion, schooling opportunities, etc.)
- Career competitive in the market place with industry recognized certifications
- Less time to complete Certification than obtain a Degree (in most situations)
- > Contributes to personal and professional development





Credentialing Assistance Availability



➤CA is a voluntary off-duty program available to ALL SOLDIERS (Active duty, ARNG, USAR) of all ranks (Enlisted, NCO, Officer & Warrant Officer)

- ➤CA is available to Commissioned officers and Warrant Officers. Officers and Warrant Officers may use CA for TRAINING only if the Officer or Warrant Officer agrees to serve a Military Service Obligation (MSO) in accordance with current TA requirements, 2 year ADSO for every credential
- ➢Officers and Warrant Officers using CA for TESTING or RECERTIFICATION (must not include training, books, materials) of a credential will not incur a service obligation







Eligibility Requirements



SOLDIER REQUIREMENTS

Soldiers must have an active ARMY IGNITED account
NO Flags/Holds

➤Training must end before the ETS date

ARMY COOL REQUIREMENTS

Eligibilities are listed at every credential in Army Cool
Be sure to review eligibilities to meet all requirements before any application





The Army Decision Support Tool (DST) in MilGears can assist you in researching options before selecting credentials and/or degrees by completing an interest inventory. The tool will analyze your input into the interest inventory, provide you with related civilian occupations you may be interested in, and will show the related credentials and/or academic degrees that support your career choices. If you find an occupation and credential you are interested in, you'll have the option to download and save a summary page of those selections that you can keep as a reference.

THE VENDOR



Soldier's need to find an approved vendor in order to utilize CA

Vendors are considered colleges, universities, credentialing agencies other organizations (third parties) that provide training in support of completing a Credentialing exam or license

Is the Vendor Vetted?

If a vendor is vetted through ACCESS ArmyU, they will show up as an option in ArmyIgnitED (check MOS/Other options). A Soldier can go into ArmyIgnitED and search their vendor and see what options they have available for training/exam. A 30 business day start date automatically populates.

Is the Vendor not yet vetted?

- ➤ In order to participate in CA, a vendor must first be vetted by ACCESS ArmyU.
- If your vendor is not present, click on the link "Don't see a related vendor?". It will redirect you to create a SNOW Helpdesk case to provide the vendor information. Once your case is submitted, ACCESS ArmyU will contact the vendor and start the vetting process.



ArmyIgnitED How to create a Student User Account



In order to access ArmyIgnitED, click on "Get Started"

➤ Then click on "Create an account"


When creating your login.gov account, you MUST use your MAIL.MIL email. (alternatively, use your personal but associate your CAC card)

> You **MUST** associate your CAC to your login.gov account

It is recommended you add your phone number as an additional authentication method. You will need to go back to <u>www.login.gov</u> and access your account profile.



Click on **Create an Account** to get started with login.gov





ArmylgnitED Validating your Student User Account Access



- > Once you've created your login.gov account, the webpage will redirect you to validate your ArmylgnitED account
- The last step in creating your Student User Account is confirming your personal information in ArmyIgnitED
- Once confirmed, you will have access to your student dashboard which opens to reading and acknowledging the TA/CA SOU before you can begin choosing your credential and submitting your request


ARMY IGNITED Statement of Understanding SNAPSHOT



- If a change to a start date is needed, Soldiers will have to send a SNOW ticket
- Recoupment will be handled by ACCESS, Army U- Soldiers will be notified by ACCESS, ArmyU





ARMY IGNITED

CA REQUEST SUBMISSION



- Credentialing Assistance requires 30 business days from submission to final approval.
- The 30 business days will automatically be populated in ArmyIgnitED. HQ Finance team pays 2-3 business days before the start date.
- Manage your account to ensure payment occurs to start training (contact your counselor)
- > You have **1 year to complete** any CA request from the start date.







ARMY IGNITED CA REQUEST COMPLETION



ASSISTANCE

- > You must reach out to the vendor and obtain an invoice.
 - Invoice needs to be uploaded into the request.
 - DO NOT PROVIDE ANY FUNDING TO THE VENDOR to guarantee anything
- Once a CA request has been completed, Soldiers must complete their request by attaching their proof of completion in the original CA request in ArmyIgnitED within 10 business days of completion, then create a

SNOW helpdesk case with attached certificate to HQ ACCESS, Credentialing Assistance


WHY SNOW?

- To request assistance from a counselor
- To submit the certificate of completion
- To request CA Request extensions
- Imperative to meet with a counselor for full program understanding

CREDENTIALING ASSISTANCE SUMMARY



- > ALL Service Members can ACCESS CA
- FY LIMIT \$4000 per fiscal year, \$1000 FY Limit for Aviation Pilots since May 2021
- ≻ No Reimbursement
- > ARMY COOL is the research website for all credentials
- ➤ Requests take 30 business days for approval
- > Upload your certificate of completion within 10 business days
- Create a SNOW helpdesk case to upload certificate to HQ Access, credentialing assistance
- > NO ADSO for Enlisted service members
- ➤ 2yr ADSO for Officers for every credential, CW2 & Up
- > NO ADSO for Officers to only Testing/ Recertification














