



 - Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, and Coast Guard.
- National Guard/Reserve members who deployed to a combat zone since 9/11/01.
- Veterans honorably discharged from active duty since 9/11/01.
- Disabled veterans with a service-connected disability.
- Service members killed while on active duty.

Out-of-State Public University: \$37,430


Private University: \$48,510


