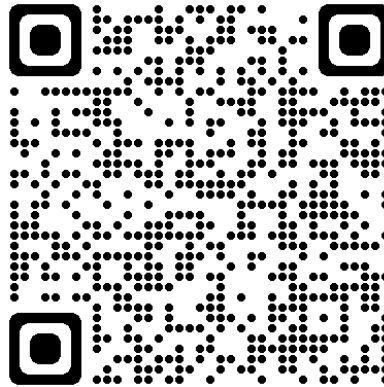

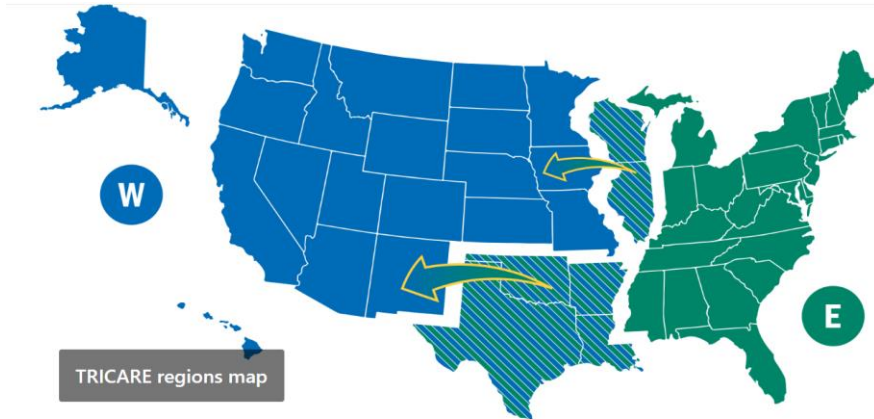

## FACING FOOD INSECURITY?

The Army recognizes that Soldier access to adequate amounts of quality nutritious food is an essential element of a Soldier's optimal readiness and a healthy home. Whether you're facing temporary challenges or longer-term food insecurity, the Food Security Pilot is here to help. If you or someone you know could benefit, don't hesitate to reach out.

### Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA) Gift Cards

The Fort Cavazos Religious Support Office issues DeCA gift cards to Soldiers who are facing food insecurity. A Company Commander or First Sergeant must initiate the referral to the Food Security Pilot Program. Gift cards can be issued to Soldiers in the grades of E1 through E6, with others considered on a case-by-case basis. Soldiers are also required to enroll in the Army Community Services Financial Readiness Course to build a budget and a spending plan for additional DeCA gift card support requests.

### Fresh Food for Families Drive-Thru

The Central Texas Food Bank in a strong partnership with the Fort Cavazos Religious Support Office, offer a monthly on-post drive-thru distribution event every first Thursday of every month, from 9 to 11 a.m. at the Phantom Warrior Stadium parking lot at Fort Cavazos. The drive-thru provides fresh produce, meat and packaged goods. The distribution is open to everyone with access to the post and registration is not required. Fresh food will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis.

### Food Pantry

The Fort Cavazos Religious Support Office maintains the Main Post Food Pantry within the Main Post Chapel. This pantry is to be used as a last resort. Eligible clients may use the food pantry one time per month.
