USCIS NATURALIZATION PROCESS

- 1. If you transfer to a new assignment, please ask to have your file moved to the nearest USCIS Office to your location. Make sure you keep your address updated so we can contact you while continuing to process your application. Any changes to your address should be updated within 10 days of the change.
- 2. To check the status of an application for naturalization, to download any USCIS forms (i.e. N400, N426, G1145), to download the naturalization study guide or to make an INFOPASS appointment, go to Caution-www.uscis.gov
- 3. Also visit our military page to see all the benefits applicable to military members. https://www.uscis.gov/military/military < > NOTE: Members of the U.S. armed forces who serve honorably for any period of time during specifically designated periods of hostilities may be eligible to naturalize. The applicant must have served honorably in the U.S. armed forces during a designated period of hostility.
- 4. Right now, we are considered to be in a period of hostilities so there is no time-in-service requirement. Also, right now, the filing fee is waived for military service members to file the N-400.
- 5. You can create an online account and upload your N-400 and N-426 there. At that time your USCIS file will be updated with your new application and sent to the closest USCIS office to be processed. At that time, our military POC will review your file to ensure the N-426 is completed correctly and then contact you to start the process of you completing an interview. Please note for Form N-426, Digital or e-Signatures from the certifying command will not be accepted.
