**EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION:** We have requested AFFES stay open on weekends chow hall, GYM maybe pool one day. Our food deserts are real on West Cavazos.

PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION: Open GYM and Chow Hall to ensure service for SM are available to all that support mission.

RESPONSE: Family and MWR provide and operate one Fitness facility on West Fort Cavazos. Airfield Fitness facility operates seven days a week from 0500-2000 weekdays, 0800-2000 weekends, and 0800-1600 holidays.

Family and MWR have not operated the pool on West Fort Cavazos for the past few years due to lifeguard shortage and approved budgetary issues and funding; however, we are currently working on a possible way forward in partnership with Soldiers and Family and MWR staffing to operate the pool during normal seasonal operations.






