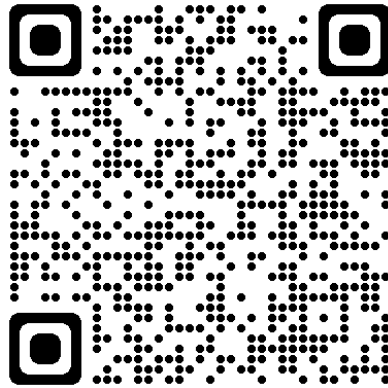

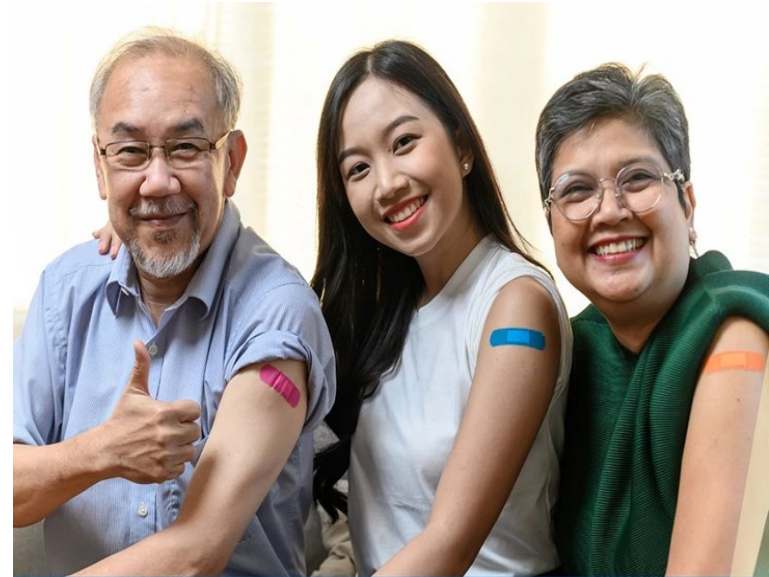

# Community Services Council Meeting 23 October 2024 Healthcare Delivery Update

The **CDC** recommends the updated 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccines and the updated 2024-2025 flu vaccines to protect against severe COVID-19 and flu this fall and winter. It is safe to receive COVID-19 and flu vaccines at the same visit. Data continue to show the importance of vaccination to protect against severe outcomes of COVID-19 and flu, including hospitalization and death.

We're building the equivalent of the "Friends Don't Let Friends Drive Drunk" campaign for veterans and service members, only instead of talking about alcohol and vehicles, we're talking about firearms and suicide.



## METRICS & IMPACT:

We have trained more than 25,000 service members and veterans in the last 12 months, including:

- [+] Through the IIIAC project, we have trained **21,580** Soldiers & leaders in FY24 at Fort Cavazos, Fort Bliss, and Fort Carson
- [+] We trained an additional 5,000 service members and veterans through collaborations with National Guard, nonprofit, and corporate partners

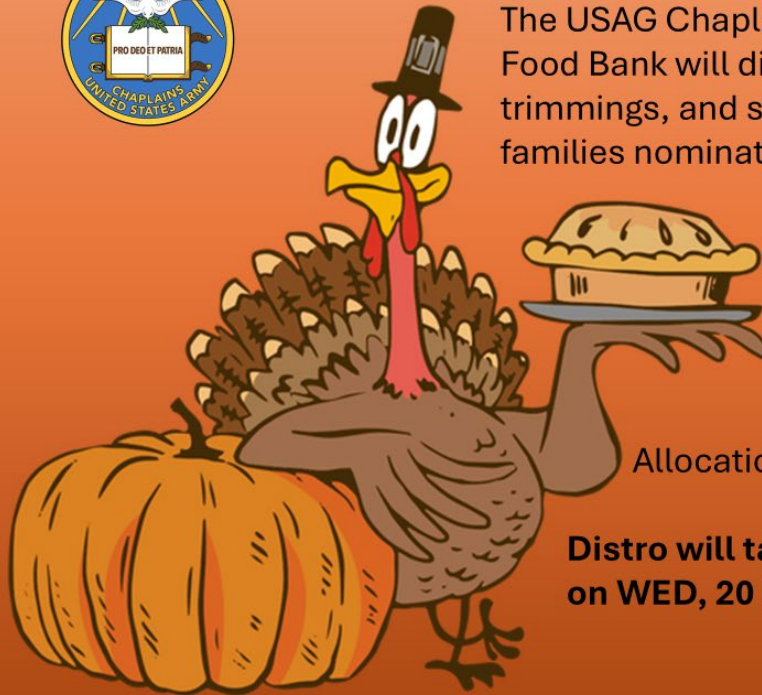

FCFSF was established at Fort Cavazos in 1985 as a 501(c)(3) private, non-profit organization under the supervision of the Garrison Commander. Designed to be the focal point for military dependent scholarships on Fort Cavazos.

### About Us

FCFSF provides merit-based scholarships to High School Seniors and Military Spouses who are listed in DEERS as dependents including Active Duty, Veterans, and Gold Star families. FCFSF outreach spans six counties (Bell, Coryell, McLennan, Travis, Williamson, and Lampasas) that surround Fort Cavazos, offering opportunities to military families in a wide geographical area.

### Mission

The mission of Fort Cavazos Family Scholarship Fund is to empower the aspirations of our community by fostering accessible pathways to higher education.

### Application Process

1. Application completed on website; online progress can be saved up to 30 days prior to submitting.
2. Two (2) letters of recommendation
3. Official Transcripts including GPA (HS Students 1st Semester)
4. 750-word Essay
5. Sponsors orders or DD214
6. Military affiliation verified through Sheer ID

### Award Process

- Blind scoring process completed by an outside selection committee
- Award amounts determined by the FCFSF Board based on Order of Merit List and **available funds**
- Awardees notified in late April; Awards Ceremony mid May.

## Fort Cavazos Family Scholarship Fund

### Eligibility Requirements for ALL Scholarship Applicants

- Must possess a valid US military identification card and be enrolled in DEERS
- Cannot be a recipient of a full-tuition scholarship (to include tuition, room and board) or an appointment to a military service academy.
- Must submit a completed application no later than the deadline **16 February 2025**. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered.

### Applicant must be one of the following:

- The dependent child or spouse of an active duty U.S. military sponsor assigned to Fort Cavazos.
- The dependent child or spouse of an active duty U.S. military sponsor whose last duty assignment was Fort Cavazos and applicant resides in Bell, Coryell, Lampasas, McLennan, Travis or Williamson County while sponsor is on a non-command sponsored assignment on orders.
- The dependent child or spouse of a retired U.S. military sponsor and both sponsor and applicant reside in Bell, Coryell, Lampasas, McLennan, Travis or Williamson County.
- The dependent child or spouse of a deceased member of the U.S. military forces and applicant resides in Bell, Coryell, Lampasas, McLennan, Travis or Williamson County.

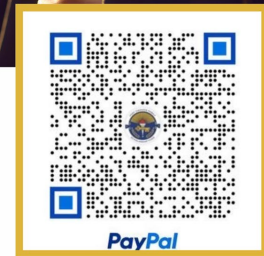


