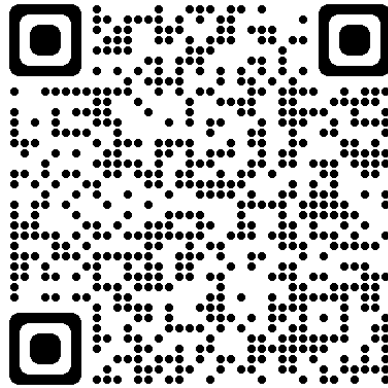

## Blue Card Updates

### TOPIC 1: Calling for doctor's appointment

**EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION:** Instead of waiting on the phone can we have the option to hold our place in line and they call us back. I waited in the phone for over an hour. I was 50th in line and only moved up about 10 slots.

**RESPONSE:** Thank you for sharing your concern and your excellent suggestion for the system to allow for call backs. Call back is not a feature available with our current Automated Call Distribution (ACD) system. All telephone and telephone related systems, like the ACD system we currently use, are services provided to us by United States Army Installation Command (IMCOM) through the Network Enterprise Center (NEC) and are not run by the Defense Health Agency (DHA) or Carl R. Darnall Army Medical Center. We are currently working with vendors, through coordination with DHA, to obtain software to provide additional capabilities, including the call back feature you have suggested. We are in the early stages of acquisition and must also ensure that any purchased system will meet the military's legal and privacy requirements.

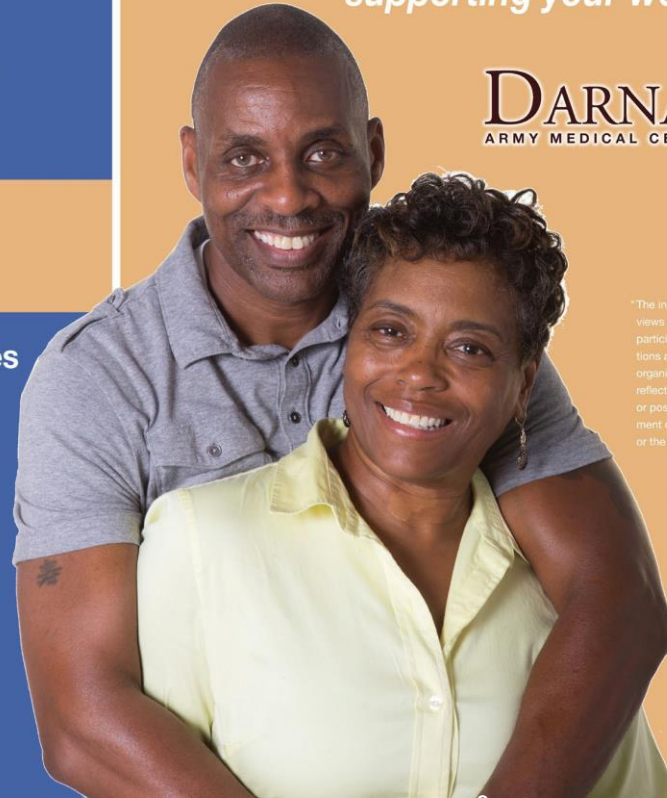

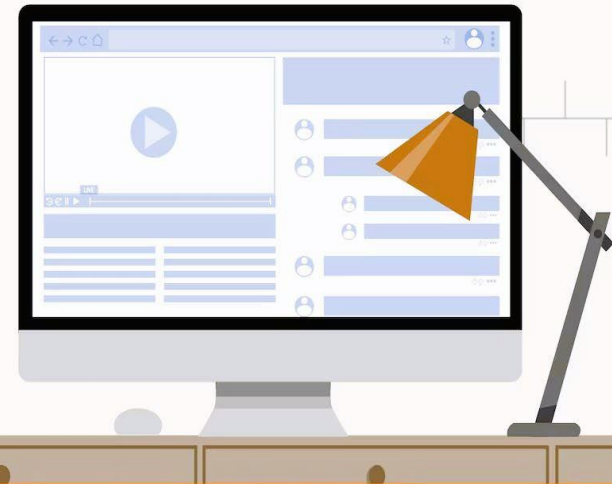

## Trick or treating Safety Tips

- Wear bright colored clothing or reflective material to make you easier to see in hours of darkness. Carrying flashlights will help children see better and be seen more clearly.
- **SLOW DOWN** - Watch for children walking in between cars and darting across roads. Use side walks.
- Know where your children will be going and who they will be with. Establish a route to be taken to and from their destination. Set time limits and check in times.
- Choose costumes, wigs and props that are flame resistant/retardant
- Avoid candles, if at all possible, and tell children to stay away from open flames including jack-o-lanterns with candles in them
- Remember to keep exits clear of decorations, so nothing blocks escape routes.

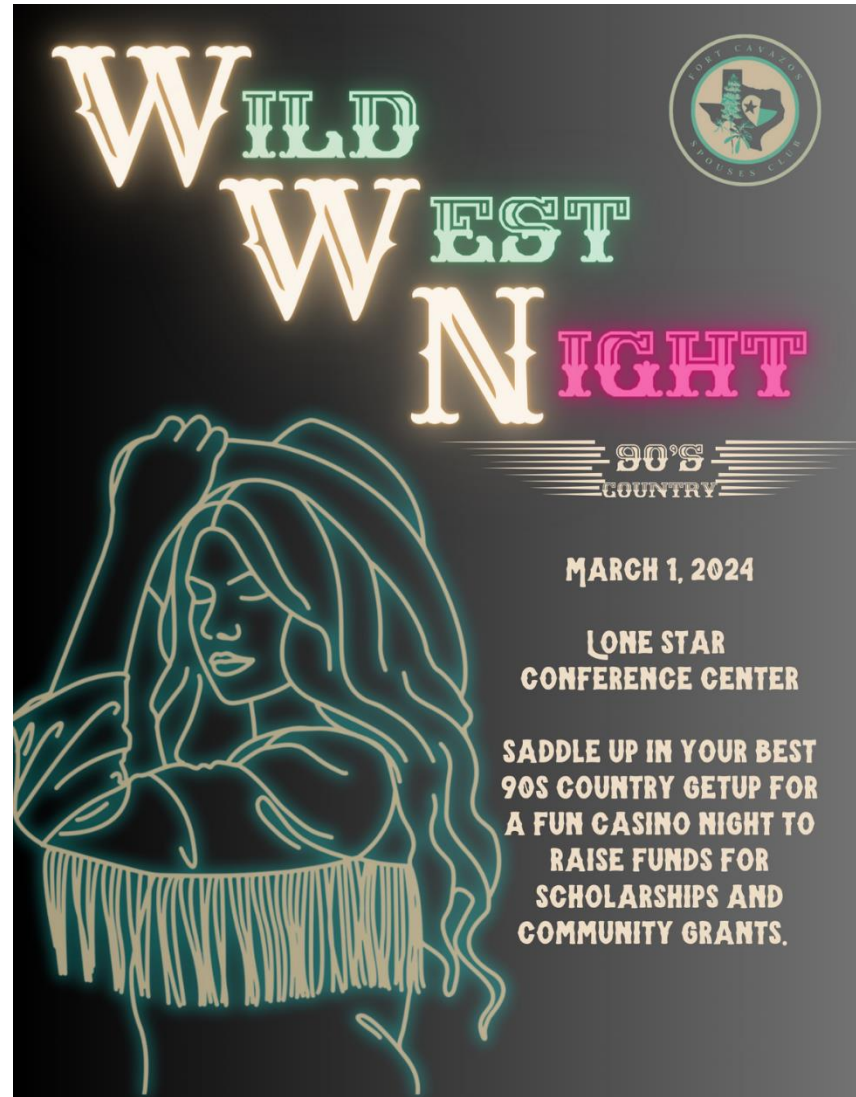

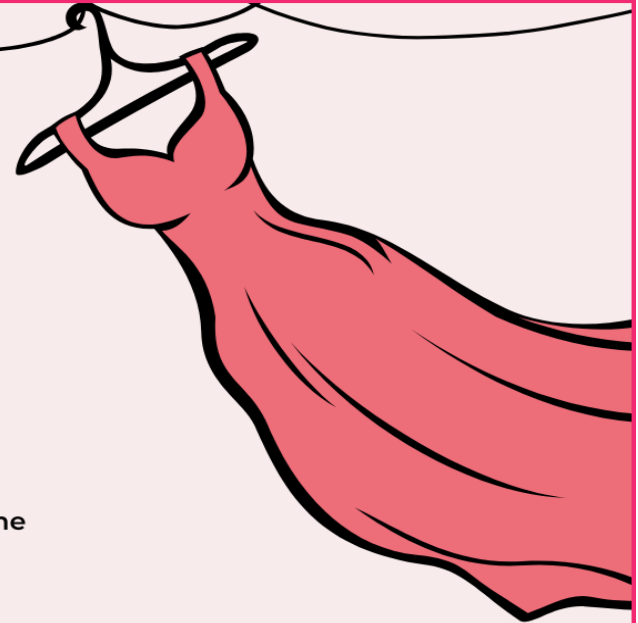

- Memorandum in support of MOVSM after 8 Donations (Approved by O-5 Above)


