

TOPIC 1: Morale Builder Open the pool on West Ft. Cavazos AAFES on the weekend is closed

EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION: Opening the pool and shoppette will help build morale but also give SM something to do on West Ft. Cavazos

PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION: Have Soldiers Volunteer to be lifeguards (2) Hire Lifeguards open small shoppette to help build morale.

RESPONSE: (WFC Troop Store): Current hours of operation are Mon-Fri 0700-1800, Sat 0900-1500 and closed on Sundays. The current sales at the Troop Store are in line with the hours. As the sales increase, we can expand hours of operation as needed. We are currently working with 504th EMIB and other WFC Commands to place and open 24hr Unattended Retail Units (Micro Markets). We also have WFC Express that is 1.5 miles down the road. We offer Door Dash delivery as an additional option that offers hot food and retail items. (WFC Swimming Pool): MWR began discussions with WFC units regarding opening the outdoor swimming pool in Fall 2023. Opening the pool requires qualified lifeguards. MWR does not have sufficient qualified lifeguards to operate all pools across the installation and WFC units do not have qualified lifeguards to operate the pool. MWR's 34 x qualified lifeguards are currently prioritized to operate Comanche Pool five days per week and Patton Pool on weekends. For the upcoming pool season, MWR will continue to recruit qualified lifeguards (typically high school and college students on summer break). If enough qualified lifeguards are hired, additional pools can be opened.

TOPIC 2: No On Post Movie Theatre

EXPLANATION/DISCUSSION: The MWR Theater closed in April 2020, due to COVID-19 and was not reopened

PROPOSED RECOMMENDATION: Open a new movie theatre to provide on post affordable family fun.

RESPONSE: The AAFES Theater closed in August 2020, following several years of operating losses and off-post competition. There are no plans to reintroduce an on-post movie theater on Fort Cavazos. Following a period of renovation, Palmer Auditorium reopened in June 2023, as a training and operations venue controlled by DPTMS, like Howze Auditorium.

Emergency services, inpatient care, and labor and delivery services will not be affected and will remain open.






Healthcare Delivery Update

- About 30% of participating hospitals received the grade A.



- Training is monitored with Goodwill Retail Stores.
- Training is done in a minimum of 3-hour increments.


